



### Take time to read with your child!

Studies have shown that being involved in a child's literacy practices (like reading and looking at books) is more important than the parents' level of education, how much money they make, or their <u>social</u> class.\*

Some even say that reading one picture book with your child every day can introduce them to over 1 million different words by the time they reach kindergarten. That's a lot of words!

This helps them succeed in school, have better vocabularies, and be more interested in reading for pleasure.

### Square Peg in a Round Hole

Have you ever seen a child attempt to put a brightly painted square peg into a circle-shaped hole? Experiencing frustration <u>propels</u> the child to repeatedly seek out a suitable matching shape. Once found, the child experiences success.


Many of our Adult Literacy Learners can relate to the Square Peg. Pressured to conform into a Round Hole education system, Square Pegs can splinter, break, and are often thrown aside because they just don't fit in. Unfortunately, most learners didn't have the opportunity to seek out a better school fit.

Thankfully, Square Pegs are intelligent, courageous, resilient, creative, resourceful, and incredibly adaptable—which is evident in their valuable life experiences.

While there isn't a one-size-fits-all definition for our learners, we can all agree they want to improve their reading and writing. Effective tutors provide the patience, understanding, and enthusiasm to create a safe space where learners feel respected and can find a snug fit in a Square Hole. Source: Tutor 8




