November celebrates International Tongue Twister Day.

Tongue twisters get your mouth all jumbled up, but they are great exercises for your brain and your mouth. They strengthen muscles that will produce clearer pronunciations and they highlight difficult sounds so you know what to practice. A dialect coach, Eliza Simpson, practices by attaching a picture to each word and swiping through a line of images in her brain as she says the tongue twister.

Tongue twisters also support repetition and fun, two elements that help with learning! Try saying any of the below five times each for some literacy exercise!

(The l<mark>ast one was</mark> the hardest tongue twister in 1974, the year Guinness World Records stopped tracking tongue twisters.)




